ADVANCE VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE: Friday, 10/12/2018. Voters that miss the registration deadline may register during early voting (see below).

SAME-DAY REGISTRATION DURING EARLY VOTING: Voters are allowed to register and vote during early voting. It is quicker and easier to register in advance, but if you have not registered in advance, you can do so during early voting with proper identification. This same-day registration is not allowed at polling places on Election Day.

NOTICE OF RESOLUTION TO ADOPT TIME FOR COUNTING OF ABSENTEE BALLOTS

On 8/9/2018, the Durham Board of Elections met at its office at 201 N. Roxboro St., Durham, and adopted a resolution of the following effect:

- 1. The Board of Elections shall meet at 2:00 p.m. on Election Day, Tuesday, 11/6/2018 at its office to count absentee ballots.
- 2. The results of the absentee ballot count will not be announced before 7:30 p.m. on the evening of the Election.
- 3. The Board of Elections shall meet at 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, 11/15/2018 at its office to count additional timely-received absentee ballots prior to county canvass.
- 4. Any voter of the county may attend these meetings.
