3 EASY STEPS FOR MUNICIPAL CANDIDATE FILING

Verify Eligibility to File

To run for office in the 2019 Municipal Elections you must be a registered voter of the county, 21 years of age and reside within the boundaries of the applicable municipality. If the office sought is comprised of a district or ward, you must reside within that district or ward. For more specific details on qualifications and offices up for re-election, click the "Qualifications" and "Filing" buttons below.

File For Office

After determining eligibility to file and making the decision to run, you will be required to file for office at the Durham County Board of Elections, which is temporarily located at 120 E. Parrish Street, Durham, NC 27701. Upon arrival, you will be required to pay the filing fee for the office sought, complete a notice of candidacy form, and review campaign finance requirements. Submit Paperwork

It is required to submit campaign finance paperwork within 10 days of either filing for office or making a public declaration of intent or receiving contributions, or making expenditures towards a campaign. It is common for the 10 day clock to begin after filing, but may occur prior. To access the new candidate committee packet, click the "Packet" button below.
